Parents attend and eat free but must submit BSA Health form A & C. (Part B-physical exam is required only if you stay at camp >72 hrs.) Parents often enjoy camp as much as their sons. Required for All scouts + adults staying more than 72 hrs. Even if you have turned in forms before please submit a current form for camp. Please make sure parent and health provider signatures and dates are included. LAST DATE TO SUBMIT- JUNE 7th 2010.

Step 4- Flintlock Adventure - Option for scouts going into 8th Grade or older - submit form by May.
