

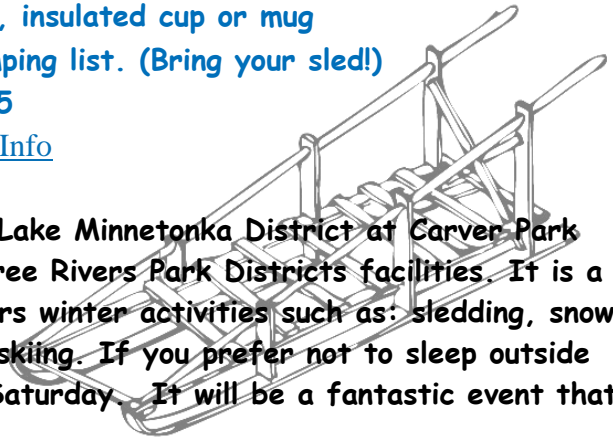


# WINTER CAMPOREE
