- What:** Camping at Amnicon Falls State Park in northern Wisconsin and canoeing the Bois Brule River on Saturday, returning on Sunday late afternoon.
- Expect:** We will be camping rain or shine; temperatures may be cool this time of year.
- Bring:** Personal gear (including swimsuit and river shoes), sleeping bag, pad, eating utensils and cup. (bring warm clothes and good raingear a must). Canoes and personal flotation devices are provided.
- Cost:** 2 nights, food and canoe rental - \$45 per scout \$30 per adult

Parents are encouraged to join us for camping, canoeing and scouting fun.

We REQUIRE 1 Adult for EACH of the FIRST YEAR Scouts. No Exceptions. The adult does not need to be a parent, but they need to be 18 or older. They can be a grandparent, older sibling, or another adult from the troop. We encourage all adults to attend the canoe trip with their scout because this is such a fun trip. Even if you are not a "Swimmer" you may still canoe. The Brule is a very safe (shallow) river and we will insure a strong swimmer is paired with you. We will transport all tents, sleeping bags and gear to the camp in the trailer.
