High Adventure Option for Scouts and Parents too!!



The Bois Brule River from Stones Bridge to the outlet at Lake Superior is arguably among the best canoeing and kayaking rivers in the Midwest.

Beginning in the upper reaches, the river offers a calm, serene beauty flowing through a narrow, intimate setting with quiet pools and small lakes before tumbling over a series of exciting rapids and chutes. Another quiet stretch, then the river begins to show some character as it roars over a series of challenging ledges and rapids through a narrow winding valley.

Who: Scout Must be 1st Class and completed 7th grade are invited to attend Parents and Guardians are encouraged to come and join us for this adventure.

What: Kayaking the lower Bois Brule River on Sunday June 12, 2011 the day after the Troop canoe trip. This will delay arrival back at WCC until Sunday night.

Bring: Personal gear (including swimsuit and river shoes) Bring a change of clothing & raingear, wear tennis shoes, wet boots, or sandals and have an extra pair with you. Avoid over exposure to the sun by wearing hats, sunglasses, protective clothing & sunscreen. Kayaks, paddles personal flotation devices and helmets are provided. Practice water safety & wear your life jacket!

Cost: \$35.00 per individual (Scout or Adult) - The **Kayaking cost is additional and separate** from the Canoe the Bois Brule River Trip.

Water safety is "Job One." **This activity maybe cancelled if we do not have enough Adults.** We welcome any adults who want to attend the Kayak trip with their scout. We also require everyone Kayaking — scouts *and* adults — to take swim qualifications and must have qualified as "Swimmer" to attend.

Departure and Arrival: We will leave Amnicon Falls State Park on Sunday morning packed and ready to leave for home after the kayaking trip. Make sure your scout brings some cash as we will stop for a snack on the way home on Sunday. **Scouts must wear their Class A uniform when traveling.**
