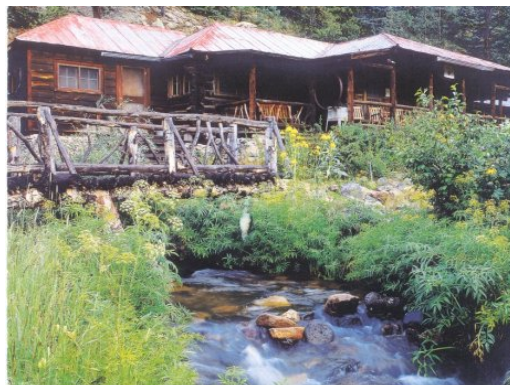


Philmont



2011 Information



Youth position may be reserved with a \$100 deposit payable to Troop 283
 Adult leaders will be selected later – we are not accepting adult deposits at this time

Time Commitment: Entire trip length approximately 7/21-8/4/11 (at Philmont 7/23-8/4)
 Crew members will also need to participate in crew meetings, fundraisers, and training events, including overnight/weekend backpacking and a personal fitness routine, for up to a year before departure.

Rank Requirement: At least First Class by departure

Age Requirements: 14 by 7/23/11, OR completed 8th grade and 13 by 7/23/11

Individuals with any of the following medical conditions should carefully read Philmont physical form before committing financial resources:



heart disease	Hypertension (high blood pressure)
insulin dependent diabetes	allergies requiring allergy shots
seizures	orthopedic surgery, injury, problems
asthma	psychological or emotional difficulties

Total Cost: \$1,500-\$2,000

Philmont Fee: \$725

Air Transportation: \$250-\$400 (est)

Pre-Philmont Stay: \$300-\$600 (est) to be planned by crew– this gives crew 2-3 days to adjust to altitude and a chance to sight-see in New Mexico or Colorado.

Misc Expenses: \$100-\$200 training costs, t-shirts, etc

Personal Equip: Varies includes clothes, boots and backpack

Spending Money: Varies by individual, includes personal souvenirs

Paying for your trip of a lifetime:

Cost can be offset by crew fundraising, wreath and popcorn sales, etc. Payments will be split up and paid on a predetermined schedule spread out overtime to help budget the costs.
