**Position Description:** The Junior Assistant Scoutmaster serves in the capacity of an Assistant Scoutmaster except where legal age and maturity are required. He must be at least 16 years old and not yet 18. The Scoutmaster appoints him because of his leadership ability. In many cases the Junior Assistant Scoutmaster has the same responsibilities as an Assistant Scoutmaster.

- Set a good example.
- Show and help develop Scout spirit.

- Must be approved by the Scoutmaster for this position.

**Troop 283 Performance Requirements for the Junior Assistant Scoutmaster include:**

- Must submit a Leadership Position Application prior to or upon acceptance of the position.
- Must attend the Troop's Junior Leader Training even if attended in the past.
- Expected to attend 50% of all Troop meetings, Patrol Leaders Council meetings, outings, and service projects. If your attendance is low, or if you have three (3) unexcused absences in a row, Troop discipline will be discussed including removal from office and non-credit for service.
